The contract Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) goal for the amount of work to be awarded is <u>6%</u> of the total federal project price. The bidder shall make and document good faith efforts, as defined in Appendix A of 49 CFR Part 26, to meet the established goal.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2. of the current Missouri Specifications for Highway Construction. The contractor questionnaire must be on file at least seven (7) days prior to the bid opening date.

The contractor's organization shall perform work amounting to not less than 30% of the total original contract price. No second-tier subcontracting will be permitted.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project must provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

The Proposal shall be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check made payable to the <u>City of Boonville</u>, or a Bid Bond, as set forth in the Bid Proposal, in the amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid.

The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.
