ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids will be received by the City Clerk of the City of Republic, Missouri (Owner) at City Hall, 213 North Main Street, Republic, Missouri 65738, until 2:00 p.m., local time on July 9, 2018 for Hines and Oakwood Transportation Improvements "STP-6900(811)". At said place and time and promptly thereafter, all bids that have been duly received will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work to be performed under the provisions of this contract consists of furnishing all materials, equipment, supplies and appurtenances; providing all construction plant, equipment and tools; performing all necessary labor and supervision; and the construction complete including all work appurtenant thereto, of:

This project will widen Hines and Oakwood within the project limits to a three-lane street with curb and gutter. Sidewalks will be added to provide a continuous pedestrian way through the area. The intersection of Hines and Oakwood will be improved to provide left-turn lanes for all directions.

A **non-mandatory** pre-bid conference will be held on June 15, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. local time. The conference will be held at the Public Works Department, 221 North Main Street, Republic, Missouri 65738 with an opportunity for site tour following.

Copies of the drawings, specifications and other proposed contract documents are on file at the office of Olsson Associates, 550 St. Louis Street, Springfield, Missouri 65806. Copies of the drawings and specifications for use in preparing a bid must be obtained from the Engineer at the above address at a non-refundable cost of \$100.00. Any bid received from a contractor whose name does not appear on the list of plan holders at the Office of Olsson Associates, will be subject to rejection.

Bids will be received on a unit price and lump sum basis.

Each bidder shall file with his bid a cashier's check, certified check or a bidder's bond for 5 percent (5%) of the total amount of the base bid made payable to Owner.

The bidder to whom a contract is awarded will be required to furnish a performance bond and a payment bond on the forms provided, acceptable to Owner, in the amount of 100 percent of the contract price, in conformity with the requirements of the General Conditions, as security for the faithful performance and the payment of all bills and obligations arising from the performance of the contract.

Wage rates paid on construction work for this project shall be at least equal to the prevailing wage rates as determined by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or State Wage Rate, whichever is higher.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The Contractor Questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

The DBE Goal for this project is 12%.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.

Each bidder must certify compliance with OMNIBUS Transportation Testing Act on the form provided herein.

Bidders are informed that pursuant to Section 285.530 RSMo, as a condition of the award of any contract in excess of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), the bidder shall, by sworn affidavit and provision of documentation, affirm its enrollment and participation in a federal work authorization program with respect to the employees working in connection to the contracted services. Bidders shall also sign an affidavit affirming that it does not knowingly employ any person who is an unauthorized alien in connection to the contracted services.

Bidders are informed that the Project is subject to the requirements of Section 292.675, RSMo, which requires all contractors or subcontractors doing work on the Project to provide, and required its onsite employees to complete, a ten (10) hour course in construction safety and health approved by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration ("OSHA") or a similar program provided by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations which is at least as stringent as an approved OSHA program. The training must be completed within sixty (60) days of the date work on the

Project commences. On-site employees found on the worksite without documentation of the required training shall have twenty (20) days to produce such documentation.

The Owner shall award the project to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids and to waive any informalities or irregularities therein. All Bidders must agree that such rejection shall be without liability on the part of Owner for any damage or claim brought by any Bidder because of such rejections, nor shall the Bidders seek any recourse of any kind against Owner because of such rejections. The filing of any Bid in response to this invitation shall constitute an agreement of the Bidder to these conditions.
