

INVITATION TO BID

Sealed Bids will be received by the City of Cameron, Missouri (Owner) at the office of the City Clerk at City Hall, 205 N. Main Street, Cameron, Missouri 64429, until **10:00 am**, local time, **October 23, 2019**, for Walnut Street Sidewalk at East Grand Avenue, MoDOT STP-9900 (126).

At said place and time, and promptly thereafter, all Bids that have been duly received will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The proposed Work is generally described as follows:

Construction of sidewalk, curb, gutter, ADA ramps, traffic signal upgrades, and pavement markings. Work also includes associated street work and all appurtenant work as indicated in the Contract Documents. The project is generally located along North Walnut Street at East Grand Avenue.

The Successful Bidder will be required to furnish a Construction Performance Bond and a Payment Bond.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond drawn on an acceptable bank, made payable, without condition, to the City of Cameron, Missouri, in an amount of not less than **5 percent** of the total proposal cost.

Non-resident corporations that are not already registered, and all non-resident individuals and partnerships are required by law to register with the Missouri Department of Revenue.

No proposal may be withdrawn within a period of 60 days from and after the date fixed for opening proposals. If the Contract is to be awarded, Owner will give the Successful Bidder a Notice of Award within the number of days set forth in the Bid Form for acceptance of the Bid.

The City of Cameron hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, and to waive any informalities or irregularities therein.

The DBE Goal for this project is 9%.
