- XIII. Attendee's Questions/Comments:
 - Q: What is the Engineers Estimate?

A: The Engineers Estimate will not be made public until the bid opening and tabulation.

Q: When is notice to proceed?

A: The notice to proceed is TBD. It will be issued after council approval and contracts are executed.

Q: What is the schedule of utility relocates?

A: As stated in the demolition plan, this coordination is the responsibility of the Contractor. The Contractor should inform the Engineer of these efforts.

Q: What is the difference between MoDOT's specifications and APWA's specifications? Can MoDOT specifications be used in place of APWA?

A: The project is to be constructed to MoDOT's specifications with the exception of curb and gutter along 12th street (Type CG-1 curb and gutter, the concrete mix design, and the storm boxes. These items are per APWA standards/specifications.

Q: What will be done with the retaining wall north of 12th street?

A: See removal plans

Q: Are items mentioned in plans but not a bid item incidental?

A: Yes.

Q: What are the differences between the three types of curb and cutter (APWA CG-1, integral, and MoDOT Type B)?

A: The details of the three curbs are shown on sheet 25 of the plans. MoDOT Type B is used along Hwy 97 (MoDOT road) and APWA CG-1 is used along 12th street and as called on the plans. The overall curb is different. The integral curb is generally used when roadway pavement is removed and replaced with concrete (this is called on the plans as well). The idea is that the integral curb is poured monolithically with the pavement replacement.

Q: What does APWA wet curb and gutter mean?

A: This curb detail is shown on page 25 of the plans. APWA has a wet and dry curb – the wet has a gutter in the curb, the dry slopes to the road rather than collecting water in a gutter at the face of curb. This project should follow the detail in the plans.

Q: When will the contract be awarded?

A: TBD

Q: Is APWA specifications for materials only, or installation as well?

A: APWA applies to both for the above listed items that follow APWA.

Q: Can standard sizes of curb inlets be used?

A: We do show APWA standard sizes.

Q: Will there be a submittal process?

A: Yes. Shop drawings will be required on storm sewer structures and pipes, seed, concrete mix design, erosion control, ADA panels, and reinforcing bars. All products must be made in America certified per MoDOT LPA.

Q: How is substantial completion determined? (Concerns that cold weather will affect grass growth and striping at time of completion)

A: Good concern – special seed mix may be required dependent on the time of year. Cold weather concreting (per LPA requirements) may be required dependent upon construction sequencing and weather.

Q: Will cast-in place curb boxes be allowed?

A: Pre-cast is preferred.

Q: HDPE pipe will be hard to come by due to the hurricane. Is it possible to use another material such as RCP?

A: Class III RCP would be allowed as a substitution. If the Contractor elects do that, strike through HDPE on the bid form and write in Class III RCP pipe.

Q: On sheet 7 of the plans, will the City adjust top of existing manhole?

A: This is the responsibility of the Contractor.

Q: What kind of testing requirements are required and who is providing or do we hire our own company?

A: Testing per the LPA manual – specific requirements of how often and what is needed.

Q: No bid item for any saw cutting, especially for the new curb and gutter.

A: In terms of the saw cut – This item is incidental to pavement removal and paid for under each respective removal item. In terms of the proposed curb and gutter, it is to be sawed per standard specs and is considered incidental to curb and gutter bid item. The same holds true for driveways.

Q: We typically furnish pre-cast concrete female flared end sections in lieu of HDPE. Several communities have discovered that the concrete end sections protect the plastic pipe from burning leaves, and the precast end sections do not float. Will this be acceptable for this project?

A: Yes, this will be an acceptable substitution.

- (1) <u>PROPOSED WORK:</u> Improvements to be completed under this project include: ADA sidewalk/curb ramps, curb and gutter, enclosed drainage and drainage culverts; and other necessary and incidental work as required.

- (9) PREVAILING WAGE (FEDERAL AND STATE): This contract requires payment of the prevailing hourly rate of wages for each craft or type of work required to execute the contract as determined by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, and requires adherence to a schedule of minimum wages as determined by the United States Department of Labor. For work performed anywhere on this project, the contractor and the contractor's subcontractors shall pay the higher of these two applicable wage rates. The applicable state wage rates for this contract are detailed in "Annual Wage Order No. 24" that is attached to this bidding document. The applicable federal wage rates for this contract are the effective Davis-Bacon federal wage rates posted the tenth day before the bid opening date and are attached herein.
