and endorsed "Proposal" for constructing School Road Phase III, 203rd Street to 211th Street (Peculiar Way), will be received by the Commission until 3:00 o'clock p.m. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 22nd day of June, 2017, at the office of the City of Peculiar, City Hall, Council Chambers, 250 S. Main Street, Peculiar, Missouri 64078, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.

The proposed work includes:

Grading, Surfacing and Constructing approximately 5,110 feet of 36'-0" Roadway with 8 1/2" Type I Asphaltic Base Course and 1 1/2" Type 3 Asphaltic Surface Course (includes storm sewer items). Project starts at 203rd Street south to 211th Street (Peculiar Way).

City of Peculiar hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that on any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, business owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

Plans and specifications may be inspected in the offices of the Cass County Clerk, Harrisonville, Missouri or at the City Hall of the City of Peculiar. Copies of the Contract Documents and Plans desired for bidding purposes may be obtained from Cook, Flatt & Strobel, Engineers, P.A., 2930 SW Woodside Drive, Topeka, KS 66614, upon payment of a deposit in the amount of Deposit required is **\$50.00** per set which includes one (1) set of drawings and one (1) project manual. ***There will be no refund of the deposit. The project drawings and project manual become the property of the prospective bidder and are not returnable.*** Copies of the project drawings and project manual are on file and open for public inspection at the office from which they may be obtained.

The successful bidder will be furnished three complete sets of plans and specifications. If additional sets are needed, they will be sold to him at cost.

Note:

All prime contractors must be on MoDOT's Approved Contractor Listing 7 days prior to bid opening. DBE Sub-Contractors must be on the MRCC DBE Directory prior to Bidding.

The Prime Contractor must have a fully responsive contractor questionnaire on file with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (MHTC) at least seven (7) days prior to the bid opening date.

Missouri Law, 292.675 RSMO, requires the awarded contractor and its subcontractors (S) to provide a ten-hour occupational safety and health administration (OSHA) construction safety program (or a similar program approved by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations as a qualified substitute) for their on-site employees (laborers, workmen, drivers, equipment operators, and craftsmen) who have not previously completed such a program and are directly engaged in actual construction of the improvement (or working at a nearby or adjacent facility used for construction of the improvement). The awarded contractor and its subcontractor (s) shall require all such employees to complete this ten-hour program, pursuant to 292.675 RSMO, unless they hold documentation on their prior completion of said program. Penalties for non-compliance include contractor forfeiture to City of Peculiar in the amount of \$2,500, plus \$100 per contractor and subcontractor employee for each calendar day such employee is employed beyond the elapsed time period for required program completion under 292.675 RSMO.


Proposals must be on forms provided.


In order for proposals to be considered to be responsive, they should include the following as a minimum
