The **General Services Department** of Kansas City, Missouri will receive sealed Bids until **2:00 PM, on Tuesday November 5th, 2019** at 414 E 12th Street, First Floor, Room 102W, City Hall, Kansas City, Missouri, 64106 for **Federal Project No. STP 3374 (402), City Project 89008182, Route 45/I-29 Interchange Phase 2**. Bids will be opened after that time at the same location.

Bidding Documents will be available online to all interested parties at the Kansas City, Missouri Plan Room, <http://www.kcmoplanroom.org>. All addenda will be posted at this location. Any document or plan may be viewed or downloaded from this location.

This project is funded in part with funds offered by the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT). The City of Kansas City, Missouri, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

Prior to Bidding, Prime Contractors must have a fully responsive contractor questionnaire on file with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (MHTC) at least seven (7) days prior to the bid opening date. Subcontractors utilized for DBE Goals must appear on the MoDOT/Kansas City Approved DBE List and on the MoDOT DBE Directory located at [http://www.modot.mo.gov/business/contractor resources/bid opening info/bidGenInfo.shtml](http://www.modot.mo.gov/business/contractor%20resources/bid%20opening%20info/bidGenInfo.shtml).

A pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 AM on the 22nd day of October, 2019, at 4721 Coal Mine Road, KCMO.

All bidders are encouraged to attend the pre-bid meeting.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project. A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Kansas City, MO reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is twelve percent (12%). There are 1 Trainee(s) required on this project at 1,000 hours

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.

Each bidder must certify that it is not presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible or voluntarily excluded from covered transactions by any federal agency and they have not been convicted or had civil judgment rendered within the past 3 years.

The contract will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.

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
