### Bridge Replacement

#### Notice to Contractors

Sealed bids for Bridge #5010012-1 Replacement over Cat Creek located on 340<sup>th</sup> Street, Section 26, Township 63N, Range 26W in Harrison County Missouri, Project BRO-B041(35), will be received at: Harrison County, 1050 Main Street PO BOX 525 Bethany MO 64424 until 3:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of December 2016, at the office of Jack Hodge, Presiding County Commissioner, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted on the forms provided.

The proposed work includes: Removal of existing Bridge #5010012 over Cat Creek, realignment of Cat Creek in the vicinity of the new bridge, and construction of new Bridge #5010012-1. Work includes disposal of existing materials, grading, drainage, traffic control, pile driving, installation of precast beams, and other miscellaneous work to construct the bridge.

Addendums to the bid package will be issued through the online Plan Holders List; therefore, all prime bidders shall be responsible for downloading the bid documents from the online plan room in order to be included in the Plan Holders List.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

Harrison County hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2016 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening. DBE Sub-contractors must be on the MRCC DBE Listing prior to bidding.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

Harrison County reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive irregularities in the bids and bidding deemed to be in the best interests of Harrison County, and to reject nonconforming, nonresponsive, or conditional bids. The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.

The DBE Goal for this project is 8%.

No 2<sup>nd</sup> tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
