Sealed bids will be received at 1902 Jefferson Street, Hermann, MO 65041, herein after called City Hall, until 1:30 p.m., on October 19, 2016, then publicly opened and read aloud for construction of:

TAP-9900(566) - This project includes the installation of approximately 3,500 LF of sidewalks, drives, barrier curb, ramps, crossings, stormwater piping and appurtenances to provide pedestrian access along Mo Highway 100 from Guttenberg Ave to Reserve Street and along portions of Schiller Avenue from Hwy 100 to 5<sup>th</sup> Street, and portions of 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Streets.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Hermann hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Hermann reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 9%.

No 2<sup>nd</sup> tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.

The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.
