All bids shall be submitted in the form of a seal envelope addressed to the City of New Madrid, 560 Mott Street, New Madrid, Missouri, 63869. Provide the vendor name, vendor address, and federal project number on the outside of the envelope.

The proposed work includes: construction of concrete sidewalk and pedestrian lighting improvements.

The Information to Bidders, From of Bid, Form of Contract, Plans, Specifications, and Forms of Bid Bond, Performance and Payment Bonds, and other contract documents may be examined at the office of the Engineer, Lambert Engineering & Surveying, LLC at 125 North New Madrid Street in Sikeston, Missouri (phone number 573-471-7442) and may there be obtained upon payment of a non-refundable fee of \$50.00.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of New Madrid hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of New Madrid reserves the right to reject any or all bids. One contract will be awarded to the lowest and best, responsive, responsible bidder.

The DBE Goal for this project is 8%.

No 2<sup>nd</sup> tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
