Sealed bids for the Proposal for the Construction of Joplin, MO Pedestrian Bridge and Trail will be received at: City of Joplin, MO, 602 S. Main Street, Joplin, MO 64801, until 11:00 o'clock A.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 7th day of January, 2020, at the office of the Joplin City Hall, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted as a Hard Copy.

The proposed work includes:

Construction of a 10-foot wide asphalt trail approximately 2,050 feet in length and the construction of a single span 80-foot long bridge according to plans and specifications. The trail will connect Missouri Southern State University to the Northpark Mall in Joplin, Missouri.

Plans and Specifications are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works located at City Hall, 602 S. Main Street. Bids must be in the hands of said Director of Public Works before (11:00 a.m. Tuesday, January 7, 2020) at which time will bids will be opened by the Director of Public Works at the Joplin City Hall, 602 S. Main Street, Joplin MO 64801 in 4th Floor Conference Room. A mandatory pre-bid meeting will take place at Monday December 30, 2019 at 2:00 p.m. at the same location.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the United States Department of Labor (Federal Wage Rate), or by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (State Wage Rate), whichever is higher.

The City of Joplin, MO hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2019 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works projects shall provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Joplin, MO reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.

The DBE Goal for this project is 7%.
