Located along N. Morley Street beginning at E. Coates Street and extending HWY 24 then proceeding east along HWY 24 ending at East Outer Road of US HWY 63 in the City of Moberly in Randolph County, Missouri

Bids will be received and opened publicly at the office of the City of Moberly, 101 W Reed Street, Moberly, Missouri, 65270 at, **10:00 A.M. on Thursday, January 23, 2020**. Any and all bids received after the time specified above will be returned unopened.

The proposed work involves reconstruction of various sections of sidewalk along the west side of North Morley Street from East Coates Street to HWY 24 then proceeding east along HWY 24 ending at East Outer Road of US HWY 63. The project will consist of concrete pavement work, portions of curb and gutter, seeding, erosion and traffic control. All equipment, material, and workmanship must be in accordance with the plans, specifications, and contract documents on file with the City of Moberly.

The wage rates applicable to this project have been predetermined as required by law. When Federal wage rates are applicable and included, this contract is subject to the "Work Hours Act of 1962", (P.L. 87-581: 76 Stat. 357) and implementing regulations.

The City of Moberly hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2019 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works projects must provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.
