Notice to Contractors

Sealed bids for Interstate 70 and David Hoekel Parkway Interchange Project; Federal Job #NHPP-4952 (604); Job # J6I3201, shall be submitted electronically through the City of Wentzville's E-bidding system. Bids will be accepted until 2:00 pm (prevailing local time) on the 13th day of February, 2020. At that time, bids will be electronically opened and read aloud. Although the City of Wentzville will conduct a public bid opening at City Hall (1001 Schroeder Creek Blvd.), bidders have the ability to view the bid tabulation from any computer or mobile device as soon as the bid is electronically opened.

The proposed work includes grading of the westbound ramps, construction of bridges over Interstate 70 and the Norfolk Southern Railroad, and paving of David Hoekel Parkway and interchange ramps.

Plans and specifications may be obtained from the City's E-bidding system at http://www.wentzvillemo.org/departments/procurement/current_bidding_opportunities.php. Bidders are required to complete a no cost registration in order to view/download the bid documents, plans and specifications.

A non-mandatory Pre-Bid meeting will be held at the City of Wentzville City Hall, 1001 Schroeder Creek Boulevard, Wentzville, Missouri 63385 at 2:00 pm on January 28, 2020. All bidders are encouraged to attend the pre-bid meeting.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Wentzville hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award."

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Wentzville reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 16%.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
