Notice to Contractors

Sealed bids for East Main Repaving MTFC-7100(100), will be received at: City of Park Hills, **9 Bennett Street**, Park Hills, Missouri 63601 until **10:00 o'clock A.M.** (Prevailing Local Time) on August 26, 2016, **at the City Hall**, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in the form of a sealed envelope clearly marked on the outside vendor name, vendor address, vendor number, county, route, project description and MTFC number.

The proposed work includes: 2" mill and overlay, optional crack seal of parking lane, new pavement markings and loop detectors at the intersection of East Main and Flat River Drive.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Park Hills hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Park Hills reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is **10%**.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.

Project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.
