

**Bicycle Facilities Improvements on  
Old Bonhomme Road, 82<sup>nd</sup> Street, 81<sup>st</sup> Street, Jackson Avenue, and Purdue Avenue  
Notice to Contractors**

Sealed bids for TAP-5402(614), City Project No. 1197 "Bicycle Facilities Improvements on Old Bonhomme Rd, 82<sup>nd</sup> St, 81<sup>st</sup> St, Jackson Ave, and Purdue Ave" will be received by the City of University City in the Administrative Services Department, 1st Floor, 6801 Delmar Blvd., University City, MO 63130, until 10:00 A.M. (prevailing local time) **Tuesday, August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2016**. The bids will then be opened in the presence of a City official, and the contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, subject to MoDOT concurrence and confirmation by the City Council. A 5% security in the form of cash, a cashier's or certified check or an acceptable bid bond must accompany each bid.

The proposed work includes: Striping removal and pavement striping and signage for on street bicycle facilities on Old Bonhomme Rd, 82<sup>nd</sup> St, 81<sup>st</sup> St, Jackson Ave, and Purdue Ave.

Bid packages are available through Drexel Technologies eDistribution Plan Room web site (<http://planroom.drexeltech.com>). Log on using your email address as your Username, and first initial followed by last name as your password. If you do not already have an account, setting one up is easy and free. Once you are logged in, click on Public Jobs and then scroll down to the St. Louis Plan Room for this City of University City project.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of University City hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award."

Special Needs: If you have a special need addressed by the Americans with Disabilities Act, please notify the Department of Public Works at (314) 505-8560 or the Missouri Relay System, TDD 1-800-735-2966, at least five working days prior to the bid opening.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of University City reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 10%.

No 2<sup>nd</sup> tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
