Sealed bids for Eatherton Road Pedestrian Bridge, TAP-5500(680), will be received at: 16860 Main Street, Wildwood, Missouri 63040 until 10:00 o'clock A.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 27th day of July, 2016, at the office of the Department of Public Works, and at that time will be publicly opened and read in the Council Chambers located at the Wildwood City hall. All bids shall be submitted in paper format on the forms provided.

The proposed work includes: all labor, equipment, and materials necessary for the construction of a pedestrian bridge over Missouri Route 100 from the end of Eatherton Road to the end of Kilare Lane and will include load rated steel bridge, abutments, center pier, plazas, earthwork, retaining walls, paving, guardrails, striping, lighting and other items identified in the construction documents.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Wildwood hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award."

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

The City of Wildwood, Missouri reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informality in the bids received, and to award the contract to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder with MoDOT concurrence.

The DBE Goal for this project is 12%.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
