Sealed bids will be received at 121 E. High Street, Potosi, MO 63664, herein after called City Hall, until 1:30 p.m., on Tuesday, July 12, 2016, then publicly opened and read aloud for construction of:

TAP-9900(567) - The project involves the construction of sidewalks, crosswalks, curb and gutters, driveways, decorative lighting and appurtenances along a portion of West High Street (MO Hwy 8) from West Jefferson Street to the City Library at Mill Street (715 linear feet), along West Breton Street from West High Street (MO Hwy 8) to Mineral Street (1,015 linear feet), and along West Jefferson Street from West High Street (MO Hwy 8) to South Lead Street (660 linear feet). The project also involves the installation of 12 poles and LED street light fixtures from the Town Square near North Missouri Street, extending southerly to the Library at Mill Street and easterly to Clark Street.

The City of Potosi hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Potosi reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 10%.

No 2<sup>nd</sup> tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.

The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.
