

INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids for the Chesterfield Parkway Pedestrian Bridge project 2009-PW-19A, Federal Project TAP-5410(626) will be received at Chesterfield City Hall (690 Chesterfield Parkway West, Chesterfield, MO 63017) until 10:00 am (prevailing local time) on the 12th day of July, 2016 and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in paper form.

The proposed work includes the construction of a separate pedestrian bridge over I-64, removal and replacement of existing sidewalk on the west side of Chesterfield Parkway East with new 6' wide sidewalk, upgrading existing sidewalk curb ramps, constructing pedestrian improvements to the Conway Road/Chesterfield Parkway East intersection, adding bicycle railing to the existing traffic barriers on the Chesterfield Parkway bridge, as well as lighting and signage enhancements to the project area and bridges. This project extends from Schoettler Valley Road on the south side of I-64, to the Spring Hill Suites Hotel, on the north side of I-64 near Swingley Ridge.

Bid packets and plans, in the form of “.pdf” electronic files may be downloaded from the City’s website at <http://www.chesterfield.mo.us/request-for-proposals.html> or may be picked up on a compact disk (CD) from Chesterfield City Hall beginning June 17, 2016. When downloading or picking up a bid packets, you will be required to provide your name and company information on a bidder’s list record and furnish an email address for receiving official bidding communications and addenda. Communications between the bidders and the City shall be conducted and documented in writing through the use of email communication to kstreicher@chesterfield.mo.us. No oral interpretation will be recognized.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 am on the 28th day of June, 2016, at Chesterfield City Hall. **All bidders are encouraged to attend the pre-bid meeting.**

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Chesterfield hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, business owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

All bidders must be on MoDOT’s Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier’s check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Chesterfield reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE goal for this project is 14%.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
