The proposed work includes: Asphalt resurfacing of North Main Street from 242nd Street to the Maryville City Limits near the Highway 71 ByPass (approximately one mile). The project in general shall consist of a 2-inch overlay of bituminous pavement with a 1-inch (min.) bituminous surface leveling at locations to smooth the surface and correct surface drainage irregularities. Any necessary pavement repair and providing entrance transitions are included in the contract. An alternate bid is included to extend the overlay project south to Northridge Drive.
