A New Airport Terminal Building Consisting of a wood framed single story 2700 square foot building constructed on a concrete slab foundation. Items to be supplied as part of the building include solid core doors, metal jambs and aluminum framed windows, gas fired HVAC including ductwork and zoned controls, wood trusses, Composite shingled roofing system, brick, limestone, and prefinished cement board siding exterior cladding, single phase electrical system, copper, pex, and PVC plumbing systems, gypsum wall board and paint, laminate cabinetry and quartz countertops, luxury vinyl tile flooring, suspended ceiling system, earthwork, topsoil placement and seeding, concrete sidewalks, other items necessary to supply & construct the completed airport terminal building.

Bid Conditions. The bidder is required to provide all information as required within the Contract Documents. The bidder is required to bid on all items of every schedule or as otherwise detailed in the Instructions to Bidders.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a bid guaranty in the amount of five (5) percent of the total amount of the bid. The bid guaranty may be by certified check or bid bond made payable to City of Rolla.

Bids may be held by City of Rolla for a period not to exceed 90 calendar days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of evaluating bids prior to award of contract.

The right is reserved, as City of Rolla may require, to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in the bids received.

Construction for this project is expected to take 210 Calendar Day(s).

<u>Equal Employment Opportunity and Affirmative Action Requirement</u>. In accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act, and the Missouri Prevailing Wage Law, the Contractor will be required to comply with the wage and labor requirements and to pay minimum wages in accordance with the schedule of wage rates established by the United States Department of Labor and the Missouri Division of Labor Standards, respectively. The bidder shall make and document good faith efforts, as defined in Appendix A of 49 CFR Part 26, to meet the established goal.

The apparent successful competitor will be required to submit the following information as a condition of bid responsiveness: (1) the name and address of DBE firms that will participate in the contract; (2) a description of the work that each DBE firm will perform; (3) the dollar amount of the participation of each DBE firm participating; (4) written documentation (signed contract proposal) of the bidder's commitment to use DBE subcontractor whose participation it submits to meet the contract goal; and (5) if the contract goal is not met, evidence of good faith effort, as described in Appendix A to 49 CFR Part 26.

The apparent successful competitor must provide written confirmation of participation from each of the DBE firms listed in their commitment with the proposal documents as a condition of bid responsiveness.
