All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The <u>City of Willard</u> hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award."

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

MoDOT and FHWA shall have the right to inspect work.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

Each bidder shall file with his bid a cashier's check, certified check, or a bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid made payable to the City of Willard, Missouri.

The bidder to whom a contract is awarded will be required to furnish a performance bond and a payment bond on the forms provided, acceptable to Owner, in the amount of 100 percent of the contract price, in conformity with the requirements of the General Conditions.

The Bidder shall submit a list of subcontractors as specified in the bid documents with its bid.

The <u>City of Willard</u> reserves the right to reject any or all bids for reasons outlined in the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition, including all revisions. The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.
