

## **Paving City of Poplar Bluff Streets**

### **Notice to Contractors**

Sealed bids for Poplar Bluff Paving Project STP-5100(009) will be received at: City of Poplar Bluff, 101 Oak St., Poplar Bluff, MO 63901 until 2:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of May, 2016, at the office of the City Clerk, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in the form of a hard copy.

The proposed work includes: asphalt paving of two gravel roads in the city limits of Poplar Bluff, 11<sup>th</sup> Street and Thomas Street.

Plans and specifications may be (picked up/purchased) from the office of Schultz Surveying and Engineering at 4482 Highway PP, Poplar Bluff, MO 63901 for a \$50.00 fee.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Poplar Bluff hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

All bidders must be on MoDOT’s Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier’s check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Poplar Bluff reserves the right to reject any or all bids. The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder
