- (7) INTERPRETATIONS: No oral interpretation will be made to any Bidder as to the meaning of the Bid Documents or any part thereof. Every request for interpretation shall be made in writing via email to Aminah Wright, Major Projects Manager wrighta@stlouis-mo.gov. Any inquiry received seven (7) or more calendar days prior to the date fixed for opening of bids will be given consideration. Every interpretation made to a Bidder will be in the form of an Addendum to the Bid Documents, and, when issued, will be on file in the office of the Authority at least three (3) calendar days before the date bids are opened. In addition, all Addenda will be mailed to each potential Bidder that purchase a set of Bid Documents from the Authority, but it shall be the Bidder's responsibility to ascertain whether Addenda have been issued.
- (8) PRE-BID CONFERENCE: A mandatory pre-bid conference will be conducted at 3:00 PM on MAY 9, 2016, in the St. Louis Development Corporation Board Room, 1520 Market Street, Suite 2000 (2nd floor).
- (9) BID GUARANTY: The bidder shall submit a Bid Guaranty which shall equal five (5) percent of the amount of the Bid and which shall otherwise meet the requirements of Section 102 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction. The Bond shall be secured by a guaranty or a surety company listed in the latest issue of U.S. Treasury Circular 570. The amount of such Bid Bond shall be within the maximum amount specified for such company in said Circular 570. The practice of multiple sureties joining together to issue satisfactory Bond, shall not be allowed. No Bid will be considered unless it is so guaranteed. Certified Checks must be made payable to the order of the St. Louis Development Corporation. Cash deposits will not be accepted. The Bid Guaranty shall ensure the execution of the contract and the furnishing of Performance and Payment Bond by the successful Bidder, all as required by the Bid Documents. Bid Bonds must be submitted in triplicate.

Revised Bids, whether forwarded by mail, fax or telegram, if representing an increase in excess of two (2) percent of the original Bid, must have the Bid Guaranty adjusted accordingly; otherwise the original Bid shall remain in force.

In case the Bid Guaranty is in the form of a Certified Check, the Authority may make such disposition of the same as will accomplish the purpose for which submitted. The project bid bond form is included in the bid book. The bidder shall mark the box below to identify the type of Bid Guaranty.
