

**Invitation to Bid

Sullivan, Missouri**

Sealed proposals, addressed to City of Sullivan, Missouri will be received until **10:00 AM., March 30, 2016** at the office of City Clerk, Janice Koch, 210 West Washington, Sullivan, Missouri 63080, after which they will publicly be opened and read aloud.

The envelope containing the Bid must be sealed and addressed to Janice Koch, City Clerk, and clearly designated as **"SIGNALIZATION OF ELMONT OVERPASS"**.

The work will consist of installation of signalization at the intersection of Route 185, West Springfield Road, and Elmont Road in accordance with the plans and specifications.

Copies of the Contract Documents and Detailed Specifications required for bidding purposes may be obtained from the office of Crawford, Murphy & Tilly, Inc., One Memorial Drive, Suite 500, St. Louis, Missouri, 63102. There is a \$35.00 (\$45.00 if mailed) non-refundable fee for each set of plans and specifications.

Effective January 1, 2009 and pursuant to Missouri Revised Statute Section 285.530 (1), "No business entity or employer shall knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien to perform work within the state of Missouri."

Bidders on the work will be required to comply with the State prevailing wage rates which will be included in the Contract Documents. Not less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages specified shall be paid to all workers performing work under the Contract. Bids shall be accompanied by Bidder's certified check, cashier's check or Bid Bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the Bid Price.

The contract DBE goal for the amount of work to be awarded is 12% of the total federal project price.

Bidder shall submit completed Contractor Questionnaire and/or Contractor Prequalification Questionnaire with attachments not later than seven (7) days prior to the date and hour of the bid opening. See Secs 101-103 of the Standard Specifications, and Rule 7 CSR 10-15.900, "Prequalifications to Bid of Certain Contractors". Questionnaire and Contact information are provided on MoDOT's website

Successful bidder shall comply with the provisions of Section 292.675 RSMo. Contract award is contingent on bidder providing an acceptable notarized affidavit stating that bidder and all subcontractors doing work in connection with the contracted services has provided its on-site employees with a ten (10) hour course in construction safety and health approved by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) or a similar program approved by the

Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations.

The City of Sullivan reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids received and to waive or not to waive any or all irregularities. The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.

The successful bidder and contractor will be furnished, without cost, not more than three (3) sets of plans and specifications for the project. If more are requested, additional sets will be furnished at a nominal charge.

The City of Sullivan hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”
