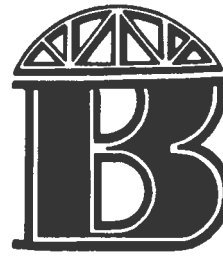

INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for **Fee Fee Road Phase II**, Project #STP-5422(616), will be received by the City of Bridgeton, 12355 Natural Bridge Road, Bridgeton, Missouri 63044 until 10:00 A.M. CDT on the 4th day of February, 2016. The bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud at 10:05 AM.

The proposed work, hereinafter called work, includes:

Fee Fee Road replacement from Old St. Charles Rock Road to Interstate 70. Work will include a 2-lane concrete road with enclosed drainage, sidewalks on both sides, curb, retaining walls, and signage. Driveway entrances will also be improved.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Bridgeton hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Plans and specifications may also be obtained from Drexel Technologies, 135A Weldon Parkway, Maryland Heights, MO 63043 / www.drexeltech.com / 314-872-0900. A non-refundable fee will be charged. Bid packages will be available beginning January 11, 2016. Questions regarding this project should be directed to, Robert E. Gunn P.E., Director of Public Works at (314) 739-7665.

Your attention is specifically directed to Section 2.0 of the Job Special Provisions, regarding Traffic Control. When reviewing the Contractor's initial traffic control plan and when considering what adjustments must be made to the traffic control plan during the course of the project, the City will place a priority upon opening the street improvements to two-way traffic as expeditiously as possible under the relevant circumstances.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% of the bid amount must accompany each bid in accordance with the Invitation for Bids.

The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder. The City of Bridgeton reserves the right to accept or reject any bid and to waive any irregularities in the best interest of the City as long as the City has MoDOT's concurrence for that action.

The DBE Goal for this project is 14% with one trainee.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
