The MSRD reserves the right to reject all bids for any reason.

The award of a single bridge will be based on the total contractor bid for Bridge No. 16300091. The award of both bridges will be based on the sum of the total contractor bid for each bridge.

If both bridges are awarded to a contractor then it will be permissible for the contractor to start & finish one bridge and then proceed to the second bridge. The contractor may also supply 2 crews and work on both projects concurrently. A contractor shall not split one crew/equipment between both bridges. The contractor shall build Br No 16300091 first. The notice to proceed date for the second bridge will be set no later than 80 calendar days after the Notice to Proceed for the first bridge.
