Bidders shall note these changes to the above Request for Quotation and *incorporate these changes in their submittal*. Bidders shall attach a signed acknowledged copy of Addendum #1 to their bid, if submitting a hard copy (via paper) or agree to Addendum #1 electronically if submitting through the electronic bid system on line.

The following revisions and/or additions shall be referred to as part of the Bid/Contract Documents.

General Clarifications:

2. The Asphalt Milling Note on sheet C0.02 states, "Install asphalt overlay within 5 working days of milling." Can all milling work be completed prior to any placement of new pavement?
No, the contractor shall not mill all proposed milling areas before beginning any placement of new pavement. The City prefers a couple blocks milled and overlaid at one time before milling additional blocks. The City will work with the contractor on the maximum number of blocks the contractor can mill before pavement would need to be placed.
3. How long can temporary object markers will be used on asphalt pavement?
The City prefers temporary object markers only be used for a three week duration.
4. Temporary object markers shall not be used on milled surface.
5. Can the striping be done at one time?
Yes, striping can be completed at one time after all proposed pavement has been placed. No temporary marking shall be used on milled surface.
6. Do you have an idea of the locations where "dig out" repair will be need?
The "dig out" repair will be performed as need, per approval by the City. No known areas of "dig out" repair have been identified at this time.
7. Will striping be done at night?
Yes, striping shall be completed during the propose night work hours.
8. Is concrete work to be done first?
Yes, the City prefers the concrete work be completed prior to proposed milling and overlaying (within the contiguous blocks having concrete work being completed).

9. Contractor would like an option for painting in the spring if weather does not permit in 2015.
Would temporary paint be an option until suitable conditions?
If weather conditions do not allow permanent pavement markings to be placed in accordance with the specifications within the working days of the project, a one-time application of temporary pavement markings shall be placed prior to the end of the working days of the contract until final permanent pavement markings can be placed. Temporary pavement markings shall be equivalent to Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction 1048.1 Standard Acrylic Waterborne Pavement Marking Paint except for weather requirements. There shall be no additional payment for temporary markings. Permanent markings shall be complete no later than May 12, 2016.
10. City to check on sequences to ensure they are acceptable.
Preferred sequence per plan.
11. How long can surfaces be left?
Several Days
12. Parking meters blocked need a 24 hour notice on signage. Only need meter bags for day work
13. Parking areas (1.5) go back to the way it was – No profile
14. Do the truncated domes have to be reinstalled before the curb ramp can be reopened?
Yes, per law truncated domes shall be installed prior to reopening a curb ramp for pedestrian travel.
15. When do the ADA Checklists need to be completed?
The City would prefer the checklists be completed as each curb ramp is completed
16. Do you have a "dig out" specs and detail?
Yes, a detail will be provided per the City standard detail 120.02
17. Under Notice to Contractors number four (4), Liquidated Damages the following language to be added...
If weather conditions do not allow permanent pavement markings to be placed in accordance with the specifications within the working days of the project, a one-time application of temporary pavement markings shall be placed prior to the end of the working days of the contract until final permanent pavement markings can be placed. Temporary pavement markings shall be equivalent to Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction 1048.1 Standard Acrylic Waterborne Pavement Marking Paint except for weather requirements. There shall be no additional payment for temporary markings. Permanent markings shall be complete no later than May 12, 2016.
