Main Street Sidewalk and Streetscape Project
Notice to Contractors

Sealed bids for Old Monroe Streetscape Project Federal Project Number STP 9900 (378) will be received at: 101 Locust Street, Old Monroe, Missouri 63369 until 10:00 o'clock A.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on Friday, the 10th day of July, 2015, at the office of the City of Old Monroe, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in the form of a paper bid.

The Main Street sidewalk and streetscape project is focused in the downtown area of Old Monroe. The project has been split into a base bid with 4 options (A,C, D and E) and an alternate sidewalk type. The base bid runs from Walnut Street to Locust Street on the West side of Main Street. It consists of 3466 sq. ft. of new sidewalk, 2 ADA handicap curb ramps, 2 (163sq. ft. total) bio retention parking islands 292 feet curb and gutter, 1255 sq. ft. asphalt paving, 133 foot of decorative fence, three small stair sets, one inlet relocation and various removals and incidentals. All available options are also on the West side of Main Street.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 1:00 PM on Monday, the 29th day of June, 2015, at Old Monroe City Hall 101 Locust Street, Old Monroe, Missouri 63369 **All bidders are encouraged to attend the pre-bid meeting.**

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Old Monroe hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

All bidders must be on MoDOT’s Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier’s check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Old Monroe reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

A DBE Goal of 10% and a Trainee Goal of 0% have been established.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
