Bids may be held by the City of Perryville, Missouri for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of evaluating bids prior to award of contract.

The right is reserved, as the City of Perryville, Missouri may require, to reject any bid and also the right to reject all bids.
