The **General Services** Department of Kansas City, Missouri will receive sealed Bids until 2:00 PM, on June 16, 2015 at City Hall 414 East 12th Street, 1st Floor, Room 102W, Kansas City, Missouri 64106 for **Project No. 89004698 / Federal Project No. CMAQ-3379 (429) / Traffic Signal Interconnect on Truman Rd from Charlotte St to Winchester Ave – Bid No. 2**. Bids will be opened after that time at the same location.

A prime contractor must have a fully responsive contractor questionnaire on file with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (MHTC) at least seven (7) days prior to the bid opening date if this project involves roadway or bridge work. DBE will need to be on MRCC approved list.

Routine warranties or guarantees provided by a manufacturer are valid Contractors' warranties or guarantees providing for satisfactory in-service operation of mechanical and electrical equipment and related components for a period not to exceed 6 months following project acceptance are permissible.

Project Description: Construct traffic signal fiber optics interconnect along Truman Road from Charlotte St to Winchester Ave to reduce delays, traffic accidents & gas consumption along the corridor.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
