

**CITY OF WENTZVILLE
INVITATION FOR BID NOTICE
May 21, 2015**

The City of Wentzville is currently accepting sealed bids for constructing or improving of The Corporate Parkway Improvements Project. Sealed bids will be accepted **until 2:00 PM (Prevailing Central Time) on June 16, 2015** when they will be publicly opened. Bids must be submitted to 310 W. Pearce Blvd. Wentzville, MO 63385, in a sealed envelope, and must be clearly marked on the outside of the envelope with the following:

Bids submitted via FAX will be rejected. Late bids will not be accepted and will be returned to the sender, unopened.

There is a pre-bid meeting scheduled for 9:00am prevailing Central Time on **June 4, 2015**, at City Hall, 310 West Pearce Blvd., Wentzville, MO 63385. Attendance at the pre-bid meeting is **ENCOURAGED** but not mandatory.

Bid packets, in the form of “.pdf” electronic files on a compact disk (CD), are available at Wentzville City Hall, 310 West Pearce Blvd., Wentzville, MO 63385 at a cost of \$35.00 non-refundable per CD. Phone Number: 636-639-2002. When picking up or receiving a bid packet CD, you will be required to provide your name and company information data on a bidder’s list record and furnish an e-mail address for receiving official bidding communications and addenda. Communications between the bidders and the City shall be conducted and documented in writing through the use of e-mail communication. No oral interpretation will be recognized.

Print Copies of the Specifications and Contract documents are available for public inspection in the office of the Director of Procurement. Bidders are welcome and encouraged to use the CD electronic files to print copies (at bidder’s expense) of the bid documents, specifications and drawings in preparing their bid submittals. The official Plan Holders List will be maintained by Wentzville Procurement Department. It is the responsibility of all Bidders and plan holders to submit their contact data to the Wentzville Procurement Department to be placed on the Plan Holder List, regardless of the bid document source.

The City of Wentzville reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any irregularities therein. **THE OWNER INTENDS TO AWARD THE CONTRACT TO THE LOWEST, RESPONSIVE, RESPONSIBLE BIDDER. THE OWNER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REJECT ANY AND ALL BIDS, AND TO WAIVE ANY IRREGULARITIES IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE OWNER WITH MODOT’S CONSENT.**

Bid Security in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid amount shall accompany each bid in accordance with the Information for Bidders.

The DBE Goal for this project is 15%.

BUY AMERICA REQUIREMENTS: Construction contracts shall assure compliance with Section 165 of the Surface Transportation Assistance Act of 1982, Section 337 of the Surface Transportation and Uniform Relocation

Assistance Act of 1987, and 23 CFR 635.410 regarding Buy America provisions on the procurement of foreign products and materials. On all contracts involving Federal-aid, all products of iron, steel, or a coating of steel which are incorporated into the work must have been manufactured in the United States. The Contracting Authority may allow minimal amounts of these materials from foreign sources, provided the cost does not exceed 0.1 percent of the contract sum or \$2,500, whichever is greater. The Contractor certifies that these materials are of domestic origin.

The City of Wentzville hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

Successful Bidder shall be required to comply in all respects with Federal and State Wage Rates, including applicable statutory provisions concerning payment of prevailing wages on public works projects, Sections 290.210 through 290.340 R.S. Mo. as currently amended, and shall pay to all workmen performing under work contract not less than prevailing hourly rate of wages as determined by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations of the State of Missouri. The higher of State or Federal Wages Rates will apply to this project.
