

## **Advertisement for Sidewalk Project in Forsyth, Missouri**

### **Notice to Contractors**

Sealed bids for Sidewalk Improvements in the City of Forsyth, STP-9901(803) will be received at: Forsyth City Hall, Attention: Ms. Cheyenne Beasley, City of Forsyth, 15405 U.S. Hwy. 160, P.O. Box 545, Forsyth, MO until 11:00 a.m., on the 15 day of June, 2015, at Forsyth City Hall, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in the form of a hard copy from the contract specifications book.

The proposed work includes: the construction of a sidewalk along U.S. Hwy 160 in the city limits of Forsyth, MO.

Plans and specifications may be purchased from the office of Schultz Surveying & Engineering at 800 Hwy. 248 Bldg. 4D, Branson, MO 65616 for the non-refundable fee of \$75.00.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Forsyth hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition, including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works projects provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Forsyth reserves the right to reject any or all bids. The DBE Goal for this project is 0%. No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.

The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.
