A. CHANGE IN DATE OF OPENING OF BIDS

The opening of bids and bidding due date has been rescheduled to May 7, 2015. The original date of the opening of bids and bidding due date was April 30, 2015.
B. PRE-BID MEETING

A pre-bid meeting was held at 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 21, in the Mayor's Conference Room at the City of Sedalia Municipal Building. The pre-bid meeting agenda and attendance list are attached. Questions posed during the pre-bid meeting are addressed below.
C. OTHER CLARIFICATIONS

- The brass historical district plaques on the Gateway feature will be provided by the City.
- The Gateway structural steel shall be painted, not galvanized. Refer to Gateway plans and specifications.
- The contact information for the precast company that was used to fabricate the City furnished storm structures (refer to bid form) is Murdon Corporation Concrete Products, 14241 Old Highway 66, Saint James, MO 65559, phone 573-265-7028. Note that the Contractor will need to coordinate completion of precast storm structures with Murdon Corporation Concrete products.
- Concrete reinforcing fibers shall meet the requirements listed in ASTM C1116, refer to the civil technical specifications.
- For all sidewalk concrete pavement, not including portion within driveways, MoDOT Type B Portland cement concrete pavement is acceptable.

Other Offices
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- See civil plan sheet 16 for coal chute detail, lean concrete shall be 1,500 psi, minimum.
- The Pavement Markings shall consist of two coats of lead-free, waterborne paint with type $P$ beads. All pavement marking materials and application shall be in compliance with current MoDOT material specifications, refer to Section 620.
