

INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids for **Appalachian Trail Street Reconstruction – Phase 2** will be received by the Office of the Public Works Director, City Hall, 690 Chesterfield Parkway W, Chesterfield, Missouri, 63017-0760, until 10:00 AM (prevailing central time) on Tuesday April 28, 2015 and will thereafter be publicly opened and read aloud.

The project consists of all the work necessary to remove and reconstruct approximately 16,850 square yards of concrete pavement with associated sidewalks, curb ramps and drive approaches.

Bid packets and plans, in the form of “.pdf” electronic files on a compact disk (CD) will be available at Chesterfield City Hall beginning Monday April 6, 2015. When picking up or receiving a bid packet CD, you will be required to provide your name and company information on a bidder’s list record and furnish an email address for receiving official bidding communications and addenda. Communications between the bidders and the City shall be conducted and documented in writing through the use of email communication to jpaskiewicz@chesterfield.mo.us. No oral interpretation will be recognized.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 AM (prevailing central time) on Wednesday April 15, 2015 at Chesterfield City Hall. **All bidders are encouraged to attend the pre-bid meeting.**

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Chesterfield hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

The right is reserved to reject any or all bids by the City with MoDOT concurrence.

The contract will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.

The DBE goal for this project is 12%.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.

A certified or cashier’s check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

All bidders must be on MoDOT’s Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.
