Sealed bids for constructing Kingsway Drive Sidewalk Project – Janet Drive to Kurre Lane, will be received by the City until 10:00 AM (prevailing local time) on April 22nd, 2015, at the Office of the City Engineer, City Hall, 401 Independence, Cape Girardeau, Missouri 63703, and at that time will be publicly opened and read.

The project consists of furnishing all labor, tools, equipment and materials for construction of a new 6' wide sidewalk (approximately 1,540' in length), ADA accessible handicap ramps, concrete driveways, segmental retaining walls including the removal of existing improvements, excavation and embankment construction, restoration of adjacent grades, seeding and mulching and any other associated items to complete the project in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by Koehler Engineering and Land Surveying, Inc. dated March 25, 2015 for the City of Cape Girardeau, Missouri.

The contract provides for the furnishing of all labor, equipment, and materials necessary for the improvement and construction required per the improvement plans, specifications and construction documents.

All bidders are required to purchase plans and specifications to submit a bid for this project. Proposals will be publically opened and read aloud on <u>April 22nd</u>, <u>2015</u>, <u>at 10:00 AM (prevailing local time)</u> in the Development Services Conference Room, City Hall, 401 Independence Street, Cape Girardeau, MO 63703.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 AM (prevailing local time) on the 15th day of April, at Osage Center at 1625 N. Kingshighway St, Cape Girardeau, MO 63701. Representatives of the Owner and Engineer will be present to discuss the project. All bidders are required to attend and participate in the pre-bid conference. The Engineer will transmit to all prospective Bidders of record such Addenda as Engineer considers necessary in response to questions arising at the conference. Oral statements may not be relied upon an will not be binding or legally effective.

The City of Cape Girardeau hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award. A DBE goal of 6% has been established for this project. Only the Work performed by DBE subcontractors that appear on MODOT's approved listing at the time of bid opening will be applied towards calculating the DBE goal.

The prime contractor must go through MoDOT pre-qualification process and be on the MoDOT approved contractor listing. The prime contractor must have a fully responsive contractor questionnaire on file with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (MHTC) at least seven (7) days prior to the date and hour of the bid opening (See Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highsway Construction, 2011). The prime contractor on a project must perform, with its own staff, contract work amounting to NOT less than 30% of the total original contract price. It is the responsibility of the contractor to ensure that second-tier subcontracting is NOT permitted on the project.

The right is reserved to reject any or all bids by the City with MoDOT concurrence. The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.

Plans, specifications, proposal form, and contract for said improvement may be reviewed and/or obtained in the Engineer's Office of the City of Cape Girardeau, 401 Independence, Cape Girardeau, Missouri, 63703. A **non-refundable** fee of \$ 75.00 per set is required.

Federal and State wage rates applicable to this project have been predetermined as required by law and are set forth in the bid proposal.

Pursuant to 285.530 R.S. Mo, the bidder must affirm its enrollment and participation in a federal work authorization program with respect to the employees proposed to work in connection with the services requested herein by including with the bid proposal 1) submitting a completed, notarized copy of AFFIDAVIT OF WORK AUTHORIZATION and 2) providing documentation affirming the bidder's enrollment and participation in a federal work authorization program with respect to the employees proposed to work in connection with the services requested herein.

Additionally, pursuant to 292.675, R.S. Mo, the bidder is informed that all contractors or subcontractors doing work on this project to provide, and require its on-site employees to complete, a ten (10) hour course in construction safety and health approved by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration ("OSHA") or similar program approved by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations which is at least as stringent as an approved OSHA program. The training must be completed within sixty (60) days of the date work on the project commences. On-site employees found on the worksite without documentation of the required training shall have twenty (20) days to produce such documentation.
