The following revisions and/or additions shall be referred to as part of the Bid/Contract Documents.

General Clarifications:

1. Temporary Traffic Control Notes
The median construction sequencing requirements described in Phase 2 Median Construction note 3 on sheet C3.01 can be waived if the Contractor installs a temporary orange plastic construction fence down the middle of College Avenue to prevent pedestrians from crossing the road before the HAWK signals are operational. This is intended to give the Contractor more flexibility in their construction schedule. Other changes to the Temporary Traffic Control Plan can be proposed by the Contractor for approval by the City of Columbia and MoDOT.
2. Add Alternate #1 - Preformed Thermoplastic Crosswalk Treatment
The color, pattern, and material of the preformed thermoplastic crosswalk treatment is intended to match the existing crosswalk treatment at College Avenue and Ashland Road.
