

INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for Sidewalk Construction along Park Drive will be received by the City of New Haven, City Hall, 101 Front Street, New Haven, Missouri, 63068, until 2:00 PM, Tuesday, February 24, 2015, in the Council Chambers, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The Scope of Work includes all labor and materials necessary for the placing of a concrete sidewalk, traffic control and other incidental items as identified in the construction documents.

The City of New Haven hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

Not less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages shall be paid to all workmen performing under this contract in this area according to the rates determined by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations of the State of Missouri.

A bid security in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid amount must accompany each bid in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.

All qualifications must be completed prior to bid opening.

The higher of Federal or State wage rates are required on this project.

The prime contractor must be on MoDOT's approved contractor listing. This requirement includes that the contractor has submitted to MoDOT a Contractor Questionnaire and/or Contractor Prequalification Questionnaire with attachments no later than seven (7) days prior to the date and hour of the bid opening (see Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction for more details). The prime contractor must perform, with its own organization, work amounting to not less than 30% of the total original contract price. It is the responsibility of the contractor to ensure that second-tier subcontracting is NOT permitted on the project.

The City of New Haven hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award. A DBE goal of 0% has been established for this project. Only the work performed by DBE subcontractors that appear on MoDOT's approved listing at the time of bid opening will be applied towards calculating the DBE goal.

All qualifications must be completed prior to the bid opening.
