No Bidder may withdraw his/her bid within 60 days after the actual date of the bid opening. Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition will be waived for this project.

The City of Bloomfield hereby notifies all bidders that this contract is subject to applicable labor laws, non-discrimination provisions, wage rate laws and other federal laws including the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938. The Work Hours Act of 1962 and Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 also apply.
