

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

City of Vienna, Missouri

Sealed bids will be received at 424 8th Street, Vienna, MO 65582, herein after called City Hall, until 1:30 p.m., on April 22<sup>nd</sup>, 20014 and then publicly opened and read aloud for construction of:

STP-9900(595) - This project includes the installation of sidewalk, barriers, ramps, crossings, stormwater piping and appurtenances to provide a safe pedestrian access route beginning at 6<sup>th</sup> Street and proceeding along portions of Coffey and 8<sup>th</sup> Streets; crossing Hwy 63; and along Ball Park Road to the City Park/Fairgrounds. The project also includes ADA parking and access to areas within the park. Alternates are included for the owner's consideration to add lighting.

Paper specifications and plans are on file for examination at City Hall and at the office of the Engineers, Archer-Elgin Engineering, Surveying and Architecture, 310 East 6<sup>th</sup> Street; Rolla,, Missouri 65401. Copies of the bidding documents may be obtained from the Engineer upon payment of a non-refundable sum of \$120.00 for each complete set. An additional amount of \$30.00 will be charged for mailing of bidding documents. Plans are also available for digital download – Contact the engineer at 573-364-6362 for download information.

An optional pre-bid Conference will be held at City Hall at 1:30 p.m. on April 8, 2014.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Vienna hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award."

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening, and the bidder must be registered as a plan holder with the engineer.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Vienna reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 5%.

No 2<sup>nd</sup> tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.

The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.
