

INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for Project No. 1148 "Ultra-thin Bonded Asphalt Wearing Surface at Various Locations" will be received by the City of University City in the Finance Department-Purchasing Office, 1st Floor, 6801 Delmar Blvd., University City, MO 63130, until 10:00 A.M. CDT Thursday, February 27, 2014. The bids will then be opened in the presence of a City official, and the contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, subject to confirmation by the City Council. A 5% security in the form of cash, a cashier's or certified check or an acceptable bid bond must accompany each bid.

Bid packages will be available on Friday, February 7, 2014 through Drexel Technologies eDistribution Plan Room web site (<http://planroom.drexeltech.com>). Log on using your email address as your Username, and first initial followed by last name as your password. If you do not already have an account, setting one up is easy and free. Once you are logged in, click on Public Jobs and then scroll down to the St. Louis Plan Room for this City of University City project.

The Scope of Work shall consist of furnishing all labor, equipment and materials to remove and replace existing asphalt pavement at various locations in University City.

Not less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages shall be paid to all workers performing under this contract in this area according to the rates determined by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations of the State of Missouri. Furthermore, the contractor agrees not to discriminate on the grounds or because of race, creed, color, natural origin or ancestry and religion or lack thereof, against any employee or applicant for employment with said contractor. The contractor agrees to include a similar provision to the above in all sub-contracts let or awarded under this contract.
