

## **ADVERTISEMENT FOR SRTS SIDEWALK PROJECT IN DONIPHAN, MISSOURI**

### **Notice to Contractors**

Sealed bids for a sidewalk project in the City of Doniphan SRTS-INF-H31H(104), will be received at: City of Doniphan, 124 Jefferson Street, Doniphan, MO 63935 until 10:00 o'clock A.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2014, at the office of the City Clerk, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted on the forms provided in the contract documents.

The proposed work includes the construction of a sidewalk in the City limits of Doniphan, MO along Vine and Summit Streets.

Plans and specifications may be purchased from the office of Schultz Surveying & Engineering, Inc. at 948 Lester Street, Poplar Bluff, MO 63901 for a non-refundable fee of \$50.00.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Doniphan hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

All bidders must be on MoDOT’s Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works projects must provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier’s check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Doniphan reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 6%

No 2<sup>nd</sup> tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
