Sealed bids for the construction of bridge replacement for the New Madrid County Commission Project No. BRO-Bo72(049) will be received at New Madrid County Clerk Office, P.O. Box 68, New Madrid, Missouri, 63869 until 2:00 p.m. on February 6, 2014, and then at said office be publicly opened and read aloud.

The bridge replacement includes, but not limited to, precast deck panels, steel piling, embankment, excavation and concrete abutments. All bidders must be on MoDot's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions.

The plans, specifications and other contract documents may be examined at the office of the Engineer, Lambert Engineering & Surveying, 125 North New Madrid Street, Sikeston, Missouri, and may there be obtained upon payment of a non-refundable fee of \$50.00.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

Each bidder must deposit with his bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions provided in the Notice to Bidders.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract, Section 3, Segregated Facility, Section 109 and E.C. 11246 and the Missouri Division of Labor Standards.

The DBE participation for the project is 5% of the total federal contract. All DBE's to be used on this project must be certified and contained in either the MoDot DBE Directory or the MRCC DBE Directory.

The New Madrid County Commission is an equal employment opportunity employer. The New Madrid County Commission hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award. The prime contractor must perform with its own organization the proposed construction work amounting to not less than 30% of the total original contract price.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening, thereof.
