36 opening for the purpose of evaluating bids prior to award of contract.

38 The right is reserved, as City of Hannibal may require, to reject any bid and also the right to reject all
39 bids.

41 Construction for this project will take place during the Spring/Summer 2014.

42
43 In accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act, and the Missouri Prevailing Wage Law, the Contractor will be
44 required to comply with the wage and labor requirements and to pay minimum wages in accordance with
45 the schedule of wage rates established by the United States Department of Labor and the Missouri
46 Division of Labor Standards, respectively. The highest rate between the two (Federal and State) for each
47 job classification shall be considered the prevailing wage.

48
49 Missouri Annual Wage Order 20 as amended December 20, 2013 shall be in effect for this project.

51 This project is subject to the requirements of 49 CFR Part 26 Disadvantaged Business Enterprise
52 Participation. The owner has established a contract goal of 10 percent participation for small business
53 concerns owned and controlled by qualified disadvantaged business enterprises (DBE). This DBE goal
54 excludes any additive alternates. The bidder shall make and document good faith efforts, as defined in

146 **Contract Time.** The owner has established a contract performance time of 14 calendar days from the
147 date of the Notice-to-Proceed. All project work shall be substantially completed within the stated
148 timeframe. This project is subject to liquidated damages as prescribed in the project manual.
149

150 **Bid Security.** No bid will be considered unless accompanied by a bid bond secured by an approved
151 surety or sureties, payable to the owner, for not less than five (5) percent of the total amount of the bid.
152

153 **Bonding Requirements.** The successful bidder will be required to furnish separate performance and
154 payment bonds each in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price at the time of contract execution.
155

156 **Award of Contract.** All proposals submitted in accordance with the instructions presented herein will be
157 subject to evaluation. Bids may be held by City of Hannibal for a period not to exceed 90 calendar days
158 from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of conducting the bid evaluation.
159

160 Award of contract will be based on the lowest aggregate sum proposal submitted from those bidders that
161 are confirmed as being responsive and responsible. The owner reserves the right to select any one of the
162 combinations of the base bid and additive alternate bid, which in the judgment of the owner, best serves
163 the owner's interest. The right is reserved, as City of Hannibal may require, to reject any bid and all bids.
164

165 Award of contract is contingent upon the owner receiving Federal-funding assistance under the State
166 Block Grant Program.
167

168 **Federal Provisions.** This project is subject to the federal provisions, statutes and regulations listed
169 below. Additional federal provisions are contained in Section 4
170

171 **Equal Employment Opportunity - Executive Order 11246 and 41 CFR Part 60:** The Bidder's
172 attention is called to the "Equal Opportunity Clause" and the "Standard Federal Equal Employment
173 Opportunity Construction Contract Specifications" set forth within the supplementary provisions. The
174 successful Bidder shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of
175 race, color, religion, sex, or national origin. The Contractor will take affirmative action to ensure that
176 applicants are employed, and that employees are treated during employment without regard to their race,
177 color, religion, sex, or national origin.
178

179 **Goals for Minority and Female Participation – Executive Order 11246 and 41 CFR Part 60:**

- 180 1. The Bidder's attention is called to the "Equal Opportunity Clause" and the "Standard Federal Equal
181 Employment Opportunity Construction Contract Specifications" set forth within the supplementary
182 provisions.

- 184 2. The goals and timetables for minority and female participation, expressed in percentage terms for the
185 contractor's aggregate workforce in each trade on all construction work in the covered area, are as
186 follows:

188 **Timetables**

189 Goals for minority participation for each trade: 14.7 %

190 Goals for female participation in each trade: 6.9%.

191
192 These goals are applicable to all of the contractor's construction work (whether or not it is Federal or
193 federally- assisted) performed in the covered area. If the contractor performs construction work in a
194 geographical area located outside of the geographical area where the work is actually performed, the
195 contractor also is subject to the goals for both its federally involved and non-federally involved
196 construction in this secondary area.
197

198 **Certification of Nonsegregated Facilities – 41 CFR Part 60:** A certification of Nonsegregated
199 Facilities must be submitted prior to the award of a federally-assisted construction contract exceeding
200 \$10,000 which is not exempt from the provisions of the Equal Opportunity Clause.

201 Contractors receiving federally assisted construction contract awards exceeding \$10,000, which are not
202 exempt from the provisions of the Equal Opportunity Clause will be required to provide for the
203 forwarding of the notice to prospective subcontractors for supplies and construction contracts where the

204 subcontracts exceed \$10,000 and are not exempt from the provisions of the Equal Opportunity Clause.
205 The penalty for making false statements in offers is prescribed in 18 U.S.C. 1001.

206
207 **Disadvantaged Business Enterprise – 49 CFR Part 26:** The requirements of 49 CFR Part 26,
208 Regulations of the U.S. Department of Transportation, apply to this contract. It is the policy of MoDOT
209 and the city to practice nondiscrimination based on race, color, sex or national origin in the award or
210 performance of this contract. All firms qualifying under this solicitation are encouraged to submit
211 bids/proposals. Awards of this contract will be conditioned upon satisfying the requirements of this
212 section. These requirements apply to all bidders, including those who qualify as a DBE. A DBE contract
213 goal of 10 percent has been established for this contract. The non-DBE bidder shall subcontract 10
214 percent of the dollar value of the base bid(s), excluding any additive alternates, to disadvantaged business
215 enterprises (DBE) or make good faith efforts to meet the DBE contract goal. The bidder and any
216 subcontractor, who qualifies as a DBE who subcontracts work to another non-DBE firm, must subtract
217 the amount of the non-DBE contract from the total DBE work counted toward the goal, as defined in 49
218 CFR Part 26.55.

219
220 The apparent successful competitor will be required to submit the following information: (1) the names
221 and addresses of DBE firms that will participate in the contract; (2) a description of the work that each
222 DBE firm will perform; (3) the dollar amount of the participation of each DBE firm participating; (4)
223 written documentation (signed contract proposal) of the bidders commitment to use a DBE subcontractor
224 whose participation it submits to meet the contract goal; and (5) if the contract goal is not met, evidence
225 of good faith efforts, as described in 49 CFR Part 26.

226
227 **Davis-Bacon Act, as amended – 29 CFR Part 5:** The Contractor is required to comply with wage and
228 labor provisions and to pay minimum wages in accordance with the current schedule of wage rates
229 established by the United States Department of Labor included in the supplementary provisions.

230
231 In addition, the contractor will also be required to comply with the wage and labor requirements and pay
232 minimum wages in accordance with the schedule of wage rates established by the Missouri Division of
233 Labor Standards included in the Supplementary Provisions.

234
235 The highest rate between the two (Federal and State) for each job classification shall be considered the
236 prevailing wage.

237
238 **Debarment, Suspension, Ineligibility and Voluntary Exclusion – 49 CFR Part 29:** The bidder
239 certifies, by submission of a proposal or acceptance of a contract, that neither it nor its principals are
240 presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from
241 participation in this transaction by any Federal department or agency. Individuals or companies listed in
242 the System for Award Management’s “Excluded Parties Listing System” will not be considered for
243 award of contract.

244
245 **Foreign Trade Restriction – 49 CFR Part 30:** The Bidder and Bidder’s subcontractors, by submission
246 of an offer and/or execution of a contract, is required to certify that it:

248 a. is not owned or controlled by one or more citizens of a foreign country included in the list of
249 countries that discriminate against U.S. firms published by the Office of the United States Trade
250 Representative (USTR);

252 b. has not knowingly entered into any contract or subcontract for this project with a person that is a
253 citizen or national of a foreign country on said list, or is owned or controlled directly or indirectly
254 by one or more citizens or nationals of a foreign country on said list;

256 c. has not procured any product nor subcontracted for the supply of any product for use on the
257 project that is produced in a foreign country on said list.

258
259 **Buy American Certificate – Aviation Safety and Capacity Act of 1990:** This contract is subject to the
260 “Buy American Preferences” of the Aviation Safety and Capacity Act of 1990. Prospective Bidders are
261 required to

262
263 certify that steel and manufactured products have been produced in the United States and to clearly
264 identify those items produced or manufactured outside of the United States.

265
266 **Airport Job Special Provision:** “Notice to all potential bidders on federally funded airport construction
267 projects: As mandated by Executive Order 12818, issued by President George Bush on October 23, 1992,
268 a Job Special Provision will be inserted into and made part of every contract for federally funded airport
269 construction projects, awarded from this or future notices of lettings.”

270
271 **Additional Provisions:**
272 Modification to the project documents may only be made by written addendum by the Owner or Owner’s
273 authorized Representative.

274
275 The proposal must be made on the forms provided within the bound project manual. Bidders must supply
276 all required information prior to the time of bid opening.

332 7. Construction and building materials sold to the contractors and subcontractors for use on public
333 works owned by City of Hannibal, are exempt from State Sales and Use Taxes. However, such
334 materials will be subject to any Sales and Use Taxes imposed by local cities and counties. This
335 change in the State Tax Law has no effect of Sales and Use Taxes imposed by other local taxing
336 authorities. Contractor shall provide proof of exemption prior to commencing work.
