**Notice to Contractors**

Sealed bids for BRO-B088(21), will be received at: 110 S. Main, Huntsville, MO. 65259 until 10:00 o'clock A.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 18th day of February, at the office of the Randolph County Clerk, and at that time will be publicly opened and read in the office of the County Commission. All bids shall be submitted in Hard Copy on the provided forms.

The proposed work includes: Construction of a 52' single span, wide flang steel girder, bridge with a cast in place deck. Approximatly 1,300' of roadway work will be included in this project, located on County Road 2660 in Randolph County, Missouri. The County Commission expects a NTP date near May 1, 2014.

Plans and specifications may be picked up/purchased from the office of Poepping, Stone, Bach, & Associates, Inc. at 100 S. 54<sup>th</sup> Street, Quincy, IL 62306 upon payment of \$75 for each set for the project which is not refundable. All checks shall be made payable to Poepping, Stone, Bach, & Associates, Inc. Plans and specification will be mailed upon payment of \$25 for shipping and handeling for a total of \$100 for each set.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the state wage rate.

The Randolph County Commission hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award."

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The Randolph County Commission reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 5%.

No 2<sup>nd</sup> tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
