The proposed work includes the furnishing of materials, tools, equipment, and labor necessary to construct **Hwy. F** Shoulder Project improvements from the intersections of **Hwys. F & M and proceeding southwardly approximately 1.6 miles** in Warren County, Missouri.

The scope of work in this project will include the widening of the existing roadway section on both sides of Hwy. F to provide for four (4) foot wide, six (6) inch thick aggregate shoulders. As a result, crossroad culverts will be extended and roadside ditches will be re-graded.

Each bid must be accompanied by a cashier's check or certified check, or a Bid Bond executed by the BIDDER and an approved surety company and payable to the Village of Innsbrook, in an amount not less than five (5%) percent of the sum total of the base bid.

Not less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages shall be paid to all workmen performing under this contract in this area according to the rates determined by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations of the State of Missouri.

The DBE Goal for this project is ten (10%) percent. No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.

The successful bidder shall comply with the requirements of Section 292.675 RSMo. The requirements include on-site employees to complete the ten (10) hour Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Construction Safety Program, which includes a course in construction safety and health approved by OSHA or a similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations.

For any contract greater than \$5,000, the successful bidder shall comply with Section 285.530 RSMo, as amended and by sworn affidavit affirming that it does not knowingly employ any person who is an unauthorized alien and participation in a federal work authorization program with respect to the employees working in connection with this contract. The required documentation must be from the federal work authorization program provider. A letter from contractors reciting compliance is not sufficient.
