**NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS NO. 2576**

Sealed bids for **BOONVILLE AVENUE STREETSCAPE PHASE 4 (Tampa Street to Chestnut Expressway)**, Plan No 2011PW0042T, will be received at Room 106, City of Springfield, Missouri, Busch Building, 840 Boonville Avenue, Springfield, Missouri 65802, until **10:00 A.M. on Tuesday, January 7, 2014**, and then publicly opened and read in Room 106 of the Busch Building. Bids received after 10:00 A.M. on January 7, 2014, will be returned unopened.

The project consists of the construction of approximately 7,500 SF of 4" slab on grade sidewalk, replacement of about 1,200 linear feet of concrete curb and gutter, about 1,700 SY asphalt mill and overlay, 450 LF new storm water system, bulb-outs with storm water infiltration swales, ornamental street and pedestrian lighting, and electrical conduit.

A pre-bid conference will be held at **2:00 pm, on Monday, December 30, 2013**, in Room 106 of the Busch Building. **All Bidders must review the work site and are encouraged to attend the Pre-bid Conference.**

A certified or cashier's check, or bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid shall be submitted with each proposal. A Performance Bond on the City's standard forms for the full amount of the contract will be required of the successful Bidder. A Labor and Materials Payment Bond on the City's standard forms for the full amount of the contract will be required of the successful Bidder. The Bidder shall submit a list of subcontractors as specified in the bid documents with its bid.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage of no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate) or the state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The successful Bidder shall comply with certain insurance requirements as specified in the bid documents.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive irregularities in bids.


Bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions.

DBE goal for this project has been set at 4%.

Second tier subcontracting will not be permitted on the project.

The City of Springfield, Missouri hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.
