Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Laude reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 18%.

No 2<sup>nd</sup> tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.

The project will be awarded based on the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder. The successful bidder shall furnish a performance bond for one hundred (100%) of the contract amount and shall file certificates with the City that he has obtained and will continue to carry workmen's compensation insurance, public and private liability and property damage insurance, and builder's risk insurance in an adequate amount for the duration of the contract.
