Notice to Contractors

Sealed bids for the construction of the Street Repairs, STP-1300 (505) for the City of Boonville will be received at: the City Hall of the City of Boonville, 401 Main Street, Boonville, Missouri until 2:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 4th day of September 2013, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in the form of a sealed envelope labeled as City of Boonville Street Repairs MoDOT STP-1300(505) Project.

The proposed work includes: Asphalt overlay of Eleventh Street from Bingham Road to Weyland and Concrete Replacement of Fuqua Drive from Highway 5 to Mid American Industrial Drive.

Plans and specifications may be purchased from MECO Engineering Co., Inc., 2701 Industrial Drive, Jefferson City, MO 65109. The cost of Plans and Specifications is \$100.00. This is non-refundable.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Boonville hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award." The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Boonville reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 0%.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
