

## INVITATION FOR BIDS

The City of Crestwood is soliciting sealed bids for the **Spellman Avenue Phase 1 Reconstruction Project**. Sealed bids will be accepted at the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, One Detjen Drive, Crestwood, Missouri 63126 until 10:00 o'clock a.m., September 5th, 2013. Please indicate on the outside of the envelope the following: **SEALED BID: SPELLMAN AVENUE PHASE 1 RECONSTRUCTION**. There will be a mandatory Pre-bid meeting to be held at 10:00 o'clock a.m., on August 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2013 in the Aldermanic Chambers, City Hall, One Detjen Drive, Crestwood, Missouri 63126.

Plans and specifications are on file for review at the office of the City Clerk at City Hall. Copies of the Bidding Documents may be obtained from said office upon payment of a non-refundable sum of \$75 (Seventy-Five Dollars) for each complete set. An additional charge will be assessed for shipping of bidding documents.

Bids must be submitted on the Bid Forms provided in the bound Bidding Documents Package and be accompanied by the bidder's certified check or bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid. A performance bond will be required of the successful bidder.

The prevailing hourly rate of wages, as determined by the Federal Wage Determination and/or the Industrial Commission of Missouri, Annual Wage Order # 20, including amendments, will be complied with on this project, and not less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages as found by the agencies or Court of Appeals shall be paid to all workmen performing work under this contract.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

The City of Crestwood hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

A requirement of this federally funded project is that the prime contractors have a fully responsive contractor questionnaire on file with the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission at least seven (7) days prior to the bid opening date. The DBE foal for this project has been set at 13%. No trainee hours are required for this contract.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive informalities or irregularities, and to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, and to award the contract on that basis. All Bidders must agree that such rejection shall be without liability on the part of the City for any damage or claim brought by any Bidder because of such rejections, nor shall the Bidders seek any recourse of any kind against the City because of such rejections. The filing of any Bid in response to this invitation shall constitute an agreement of the Bidder to these conditions.
