

NOTICE TO BID

CITY OF CAPE GIRARDEAU, MO

Sealed proposals will be received for the Cape LaCroix Trail and Shawnee Park Connections, Project No. STP-1500(021) at the Office of the City Engineer, City Hall, 401 Independence Street, Cape Girardeau, Missouri 63703, until 10:00 a.m., local time, August 14, 2013.

The project consists of the construction of approximately 325 linear feet of an 8 feet wide mixed-use trail from the existing Cape LaCroix Trail to the southern softball fields and construction of approximately 1,425 linear feet of an 8 feet wide mixed-use trail and approximately 475 linear feet of a 6 feet wide sidewalk from the south end of the Cape LaCroix Trail at Cape LaCroix Creek to the intersection of West End Boulevard and Linden Street and any other related construction items as stated in the Specifications or shown on the Project Plans prepared by Bowen Engineering & Surveying, Inc. and Dated: June 24, 2013.

The Contract provides for the furnishing of all labor, equipment, and materials necessary for the improvement and construction required per the improvement plans, specifications and construction documents.

All bidders are required to purchase plans and specifications to submit a bid for this project. Proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud on August 14, 2013 at 10:00 a.m., local time in the Office of the City Engineer.

A certified or cashier's check, or bid bond executed by the bidder and an approved Surety Company, in the amount of five percent of the bid shall be submitted with each Proposal.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 a.m., local time, July 30, 2013, at the Shawnee Park Center, 835 S. West End Boulevard, Cape Girardeau, MO 63703. Representatives of the Owner and Engineer will be present to discuss the project. Bidders are <u>required</u> to attend and participate in the pre-bid conference. The Engineer will transmit to all prospective Bidders of record such Addenda as Engineer considers necessary in response to questions arising at the conference. Oral statements may not be relied upon and will not be binding or legally effective.

The City of Cape Girardeau hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder. The Owner reserves the right to waive all informalities not involving price, time or changes in Work and to negotiate contract terms with the Successful Bidder.

Plans, specifications, proposal form, and contract for said improvement may be seen and/or obtained in the Office of the City Engineer, City Hall, 401 Independence Street, Cape Girardeau, Missouri 63703. A **non-refundable** fee of \$\frac{75.00}{2}\$ per set is required. All bidders are required to purchase plans and specifications to submit a bid for this project.

All wages paid for work under this Contract shall comply with requirements of the prevailing wage law of the State of Missouri, Sec. 290.210 through 290.340, R.S. Mo. 1978, as amended. Bidders must agree to comply with all statutory regulations referred to in the specifications. Weekly certified payrolls will be required from the General Contractor and Subcontractors.

Pursuant to 285.530 R.S. Mo, the bidder must affirm its enrollment and participation in a federal work authorization program with respect to the employees proposed to work in connection with the services requested herein by including with the bid proposal 1) submitting a completed, notarized copy of AFFIDAVIT OF WORK AUTHORIZATION and 2) providing documentation affirming the bidder's enrollment and participation in a federal work authorization program with respect to the employees proposed to work in connection with the services requested herein.

Additionally, pursuant to 292.675, R.S. Mo, the bidder is informed that all contractors or subcontractors doing work on this project to provide, and require its on-site employees to complete, a ten (10) hour course in construction safety and health approved by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration ("OSHA") or similar program approved by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations which is at least as stringent as an approved OSHA program. The training must be completed within sixty (60) days of the date work on the project commences. On-site employees found on the worksite without documentation of the required training shall have twenty (20) days to produce such documentation.
