20th Street Transit, Pedestrian and Bicycle Facility Rangeline Road (Bus. 71) to Murphy Boulevard TDG-3200(718) Project 5

This work consists of constructing a 10' wide shared use path along the north and south side of 20th Street from Highview Avenue to Murphy Boulevard, minor ADA improvements from Highview Avenue to Rangeline Road, and construction of a pull out for a trolley stop.

Main Street, 4th floor Engineering Department. Bona fide general contractors may secure copies of the proposed Contract Documents from the office of the Director of Public Works. The prime contractor must have a full responsive contractor questionnaire on file with the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission at least seven (7) days prior to the bid opening date. Second tier subcontracting will not be permitted on this project. It will be the responsibility of the contractor that his subcontractors do not in turn subcontract any portion of the work.

The wage rates applicable to this project have been predetermined as required by law and are set forth in the construction specifications and are to be considered as a part of this Notice to Contractors. If Federal Wage Rates are applicable the proposal must state the higher of two State or Federal Wages apply.

The bid will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder. No preference shall be given to contractors for business location.

Payment for this project will be made to the contractor in cash.

The Director of Public Works reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
